📍 Reason for Choosing Kwangwoon University



- If it is proven that submitted documents have been forged or illegally obtained, registration/admission will be revoked.
- Submitted documents will not be returned to the applicant, and the documents required for visa issuance or change must be prepared by the applicant.**
- Any disadvantages due to typos of the completed application form will be the responsibility of the applicant.
- Applicants must be reachable through contact information provided by the applicants during the admission period. Any disadvantages that may befall the applicants for their lack of response, whether it's due to their negligence, or by error or change in contact information will be the responsibility of the applicants.
- The applicants who are scheduled to graduate or are scheduled to complete the previous educational process, provided that the applicant passes the admission, must submit a certificate of graduation to the office of the international exchange team of this school by July 17th(Fri), 2026.
- Should there be conflicting contents between the translated brochure and the Korean brochure, the contents in the Korean version supersede the counterparts.
- The online application will be completed after online payment, and the submitted documents and application fee cannot be canceled, changed or returned.
